NOTICE OF RACE

For
2019/20 Chandler Macleod Moth State Championships

22nd-24th November 2019
Mounts Bay Sailing Club

[NP] – denotes that a breach of this rule will not be grounds for protest by a boat.

[DP] – denotes a rule of which the penalty is at the discretion of the protest committee and may be less than disqualification.

1 RULES

- 1.1** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* except as any of these is altered by this Notice of Race or by the Sailing Instructions and/or the Moth Class rules.
- 1.2** The Australian Sailing Prescriptions shall apply to all entries.
- 1.3** [DP] The Australian Sailing Special Regulations Part 2 Off the Beach, will apply.
- 1.4** Racing rule 44.1 will be changed as follows: The two-turns penalty in rule 44.1 is replaced by a part-turn. It shall consist of
 - A gybe and coming to close-hauled course whilst on a windward leg,
 - A tack and sailing to a true wind angle greater than 90 degrees on any other leg.
- 1.5** Appendix T will apply.

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1** [DP] Boats may be required to display advertising as chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies.

3 ELIGIBILITY, FEES, and ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Moth Class.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form attached with this NOR and making the payment of \$100. Entries must be received by close of business, 18th of November 2019.
- 3.3 Late entries will be accepted with a late fee of an additional \$50.
- 3.4 To be eligible to compete in this event each competitor shall be a financial member of a Club recognised by the competitor's National Authority.
- 3.5 All helms less than 18 years of age during the event shall submit signed Parent/Guardian Declarations.

4 SCHEDULE

5 MEASUREMENT

- 5.1 All boats shall comply with RRS 78.1
- 5.2 Competitors shall not change rudders, verticals, horizontal T-foils, while afloat. Any change of rig or foils must take place ashore at the regatta venue.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 6.1 The Sailing Instructions (SI) will be available prior to the event.

7 VENUE & COURSE AREAS

- 7.1 The Host Club shall be Mounts Bay Sailing Club (MBSC). All Registration, sign on/sign off shall occur at MBSC.
- 7.2 Racing Areas will be Matilda Bay and Melville Water.
- 7.3 Appendix A shows the location of the regatta venue and course areas.
- 7.4 Racing areas will not be considered exclusive and encroaching other areas during a race shall not incur a penalty.
- 7.5 All Competitors are expected to familiarise themselves with shallow areas before entering the water.

8 COURSES

8.1 Friday - Windward/Leeward courses with Grand Prix finish. Slalom Course will be in Matilda Bay.

8.2 Saturday/Sunday - Windward/leeward courses with Grand Prix finish

9 PENALTY SYSTEM

9.1 RRS 44.1 is changed as described in NOR 1.4.

9.2 The Post-Race Penalty in RRS T1(B) is changed to 25% of the difference.

10 SCORING

10.1 A minimum of three races shall be completed to constitute a series.

10.2 The scoring system will be described in full in the sailing instructions.

10.3 For each class, the protest time limit and redress time limit is 45 minutes after the last race of the day "or two hours after the incident, whichever is later" is deleted from RRS 62.2.

11 SUPPORT BOATS

11.1 Support boats are allowed and shall be registered with the OA and shall have a working VHF radio for communications with Race Committee and shall act as rescue boats if required to do so. [DP]

12 PRIZES

12.1 The following championship prizes will be awarded,

- Overall Moth State Champion: 1st, 2nd, 3rd
- Slalom: 1st
- Rookie Award

12.2 Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the OA.

13 INSURANCE

13.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10,000,000AUD per incident or the equivalent in currency.

13.2 Proof of Insurance shall be provided on registration.

14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

14.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4 RRS, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

14.2 The Organising Authority, host club or their staff and volunteers will not accept any liability for any damage or loss caused to boats berthed at the event.

15 SOCIAL

15.1 The Mounts Bay Sailing Club Bar will be open following each days racing.

15.2 A presentation gathering will be held at Mounts Bay Sailing Club at 2:00pm on Sunday, 24 November 2018.
